

1. No Examinee shall be permitted to enter the examination hall without the printed Admit Card and a valid ID proof.
2. No materials or belongings other than Pen, Pencil, Admit Card and ID proof shall be allowed.
3. Possession of handwritten / printed material / electronic gadgets in any form is strictly prohibited for the examinee.
4. No examinee shall be allowed to enter the Examination Hall after 10:15 AM.
5. The examinee shall not be permitted to answer the natural call during the examination.
6. The examinee shall not submit the answer sheet before the completion of the Examination.
7. Verbal or Non – Verbal Communication between Examinees is strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall and any such activity shall amount to Unfair Means.
8. The Admit Card duly signed by the invigilator should be retained and produced by the candidate at the time of counselling.
9. The following practices will disqualify the candidate, if found:
