




## Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) Report on Overall Institutional Performance for the Academic Year 2021-22




A total of 102 students participated in the survey. Their response was saved and analysed. Detailed Report of the student satisfaction survey is given below:
























































## Any other suggestion that you would like to give to improve the overall performance of the institution
