- CNLU will admit 8th batch of LL.M. with six specialisations (*viz.* Constitutional Law and Administrative Law, International Law, Corporate and Commercial Law, Intellectual Property Law, Criminal Law & Human Rights) based on entrance test which is scheduled to be held on May 19, 2024.

8. Examination Reforms

- Hall tickets for the first time were issued to students for appearing in End Semester Examinations of various courses which has led to the recovery of due Fee amounting to Rs.11.5 Crores.
- Grade sheet to passed out students of different semesters has been issued for the first time to students of UG and PG courses.
- Question papers of examinations have been made more detailed and challenging to test in depth knowledge of students.
- Students have been provided greater freedom to work on projects of varied nature.
- Diversification project has reduced the stress of academic stain that was adversely affecting the mental health of students.
- Plagiarism testing of final draft of project has been made compulsory even at the undergraduate level through Turnitin Plagiarism software to strengthen creativity and instil research ethics amongst students.
- NAD-digilocker has been made operational and certificates of passed out students is being uploaded with considerable speed.

11. Enrichment of Library Resources

- For the first time in the history of CNLU highest ever investment was made in the library with approx. Rs. 3 Crores. This amount has been invested in the library to procure textbooks, reference books, e-books and journals and e-databases. We also renewed the subscription of journals which library had already subscribed. University also renewed the subscription of library automation software KOHA as well as RFID agreement.

- Comprehensive counselling facility is provided throughout the year to all the students and staff of the University by Dr. Samidha Pandey who is an experienced counsellor and psychiatrist.



15. Advance Research Centre / Chairs

➤ Child Rights Centre (CRC)

(April 2023 to March 2024)

- On 6th April 2023, The Child Rights Centre (CRC) participated in the deliberation on existing Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) on Human Trafficking at the Labor Resource Department, Government of Bihar. It made a presentation on the SOP '*Children on Move.*'
- On 6th April 2023, Dr Aman Kumar, Centre Coordinator, CRC, participated as a resource person and made presentation on the topic '*Child Participation: Perspectives from Juvenile Justice Act*' in a session on '*Child participation in Care Interventions.*' The event was organised by Rainbow Home at the National Institute for Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (NIMSME) in Hyderabad.
- On 12th April 2023, CRC organised a one-day workshop with elected representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions on the working of Child Protection Committees at the panchayat level and steps to develop "*child-friendly panchayats*" in Bihar.
- On 15th April 2023, Dr Aman Kumar, Centre Coordinator, CRC, participated as a resource person in the event on "*International Day for Street Children*". Rainbow Homes Programme in Patna organized this event to sensitize the stakeholders regarding street children in Patna. The event focused on rights and welfare of street children.
- On 26th April, 2023, CRC submitted the result of recruitment examination of the *social members of the Juvenile Justice Board and Chairperson/Members of the Child Welfare Committee*, which CRC-CNLU had conducted on 26/03/2023.
- On 4th May, 2023, CRC in collaboration with Rainbow Home held a meeting with members of the *Bihar State Commission for the Protection of Child Rights* in CNLU a to explore potential collaboration between the Bihar State Commission, Rainbow Homes Programme, and CRC at Chanakya National Law University to strengthen child protection measures and enhance the well-being of children in Bihar.



- On 9th May, 2023, CRC held meeting with Professor *Raj Kachroo, President of the National Federation of Societies for Fast Justice*, to explore potential collaboration between the organisation, Legal Aid Cell, CNLU, Patna and CRC. The agenda of this meeting was to implement the toll-free number 15100 and establish an online Legal Aid Cell at the university.
- On 9th May, 2023, CRC provided training to police officers on Human Trafficking and its impact on vulnerable groups like children. This capacity-building programme was organized with SSP Patna and the Kailash Satyarthi Foundation.
- On 15th May, 2023, the CRC organized a State Level Workshop on the research study report titled "*To Address Issues of Women Police Personnel.*" conducted by the Centre for the Sustainable Use of Natural Social Resources (CSNR). The workshop was aimed to disseminate the study's findings, facilitate discussions, and involve stakeholders in addressing the challenges faced by women in law enforcement.
- On 15th May, 2023, the CRC facilitated *Students of Delhi Public School, Patna* in their interaction with street children and also sensitized students about the life and circumstances of street children in street situation. Students from DPS, Patna and street children at Rainbow Homes in Rajbanshi Nagar, Patna performed collaborative activities jointly.
- On 12th June, 2023, the CRC observed *World Day Against Child Labour* with the children of the Rainbow Homes Programme. On this day, children of Rainbow Home staged a powerful street play aimed at raising awareness and fighting against child labour.
- On 19th June, 2023, the CRC conducted a consultation at Raxaul SSB HQ with different stakeholders along the Bihar-Nepal border to gain an understanding of *cross-border child trafficking* and challenges of different stakeholders on either side of the border.
- On 21st June, 2023, the CRC conducted a *consultation at Sonbarsa SSB HQ* with different stakeholders along the Bihar-Nepal border to gain an understanding of cross-border child trafficking and challenges of different stakeholders on either side of the border.
- On 23rd June, 2023, the CRC conducted a *consultation at Bathnaha SSB HQ* with different stakeholders along the Bihar-Nepal border to gain an understanding of *cross-border child trafficking* and challenges of different stakeholders on either side of the border.

- From 22nd June to 24th June 2023, Dr Aman Kumar, Centre Coordinator, CRC, served as a resource person on Human Trafficking in a *Capacity Building Programme* for the Women Panchayat Leaders. The National Commission for Women, New Delhi, funded this capacity-building programme.
- On 27th June, 2023, the CRC and the Legal Aid Cell, CNLU Patna organized a *One-Day Training Program for Probation Officers*. The agenda of this event was to strengthen skills of newly recruited probation officers.
- On 11th August, 2023, student members of the CRC visited *Bihar Bal Bhawan Kilkari* to raise awareness among adolescents on the issue of drug addiction, health hygiene, and future career development.

Funding of CRC

- Rs 15,46,650 as a grant from UNICEF Bihar received by the CRC for various projects such as education, healthcare, and protection against exploitation and abuse, spanning from July to September 2023.
- Rs 15,82,035 as a grant from UNICEF Bihar received by the CRC for various projects, such as education, healthcare, and protection against exploitation and abuse, from December 2023 to February 2024.
- On 13th September, 2023, Mrs Shashi Sharma, JJB member, delivered a lecture on “Role and Responsibilities of at the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB)” in CRC. She emphasised the crucial function of JJB in protecting children's rights.
- On 14th September, 2023, Mr Sanju Singh, Advocate Patna High Court, delivered a guest lecture on the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, in CRC conference hall.

Upon visit, the members were attended by the Assistant Superintendent of Beur jail and they had an in-depth discussion regarding the status of under-trial prisoners, on their condition in jails, and reports on data of prisoners were sought.
- Collaboration for Legal Aid: CNLU Initiative with Bihar State Legal Services Authority



- On January 23, 2024, members of the CNLU Legal Aid Cell initiated discussions with the Bihar State Legal Service Authority (BSLSA) to undertake a project focusing on undertrial prisoners in Bihar. The objective was to gather comprehensive information about the condition of undertrial prisoners, the rate of case disposal, and the extent of legal assistance provided to indigent prisoners by the legal services authority.
- The meeting concluded with a promise of collaboration between CNLU Legal Aid Cell and BSLSA to address the challenges faced by undertrial prisoners in Bihar. This collaboration holds the potential to bring about positive changes in the legal landscape and contribute to ensuring justice for underprivileged individuals in Bihar.
- Promoting Legal Awareness: Guest Lecture on the Role of Law Students in Lok Adalat
- On February 6, 2024, the Legal Aid Cell of Chanakya National Law University (CNLU), in collaboration with the Bihar State Legal Services Authority (BSLSA), organized a guest lecture on "*The Role of Law Students in Lok Adalat.*" The objective was to educate CNLU students about their potential contributions to the Lok Adalat system and foster their understanding of legal aid principles.
- The event featured Ms. Shilpee Soniraj, a District and Session Judge, and Member Secretary of the Bihar Legal Services Authority, Patna, as the esteemed speaker. Notable attendees included Dhristi Jasleen Sharma, Joint Secretary of BALSAs (Legal Aid Cell), and Ms. Neha Niharika, Assistant Registrar at BALSAs.
- The guest lecture provided CNLU students with valuable insights into their potential role in promoting access to justice through Lok Adalat.
- **CNLU Legal Aid Cell's Engagement with Bihar Prison Authorities**
- On February 19, 2024, members of the CNLU Legal Aid Cell undertook a visit to the old secretariat to meet with the Inspector General (Prison), Bihar. The primary objective was to submit an application seeking data on under-trial prisoners in Bihar and to discuss the current status of case backlog and disposal in the state. Additionally, the students aimed to discuss their previous visit to Beur Central Jail and engage with probation officers regarding the status of under-trial prisoners.



VIDHIKTA 2.0 (06.10.2023 to 08.10.2024)

- Legal Aid Cell organised the second edition of its flagship event, Vidhikta 2.0 which aims to target all those who belong to the legal fraternity. - Prof Amitabh Kundu chaired the conversation with his comments and provided a brief of the importance of a study at the state level and the key element being the use of publicly available government data. The focus, he stressed, is to be on religion based discrimination in education, healthcare, labour markets etc and not religious



discrimination. Another senior economist and professor, Santosh Mehrotra explained and presented his thoughts on the issues of employment, particularly Bihar's youth employment and the low-income trap.

22. Students' Participation in the Governance of University

- To make the governance and decision making of the University more democratic, participative and inclusive, student members have been added for the first time in CNLU in almost all committees of the University. This participative inclusion of students is well reflected even in decision making process of procurement, purchasing and tendering process. Entire decision-making process with the participation of students percolating from top to bottom has been made more student centric and student friendly. Even in selection and purchasing of library resources student members not only actively participated but even finalised the entire purchasing decision.
- The Vice-Chancellor regularly holds general and special open houses in which all the students of the University are invited to participate and freely express their grievances and concerns. The Vice-Chancellor also conducts open houses before and after the meetings of the Academic Council, Executive Council, Finance Committee and General Council to consult the students on the proposed agenda items and after the meeting the decisions of the University authorities.
- A day long consultation was held with various committees of the students on the allocation of funds in the budget 2024-2025 and after the finalisation of budget an open house held to brief the students the financial health of the University and budgetary allocation.
- No Indian University has this kind of active involvement and participation of students in the University and taking of all decisions on financial matters.

24. Welfare Measures for Faculty and Staff

7. Adoption of select SWAYAM Courses
8. Institution of Gold Medals by the University
9. To organise First Alumni, Meet. It would be held in month of July 2024.
10. Registration for the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)
11. Admission in LL.M. course through CLAT
12. Establishment of a Chair of Cross-Border Insolvency laws was established at CNLU and a Regional Centre for Insolvency.

17. The Academic and Research Incentive Policy approved by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 10.10.2023 and the Executive Council in its meeting held on 11.10.2023, will be implemented from the financial year 2024-25.
18. Revamping of Ph.D. programme-
 - (i) The Ph.D. Regulations have been amended whereby only full time Ph.D. programme will be offered by the University and Part-time Ph.D. programme has been discontinued.
 - (ii) With the objective of improving the research output of the University, periodic assessment of the progress reported by the research scholars has been introduced for the first time in the University.



- **Future Plans-**

- Post Doctoral Fellowship Regulations as approved by the Academic and Executive Council in their meeting held on 10.10.2023 and 11.10.2023 respectively will be implemented from the Academic year 2024-25. Under the scheme the University shall pay a monthly fellowship of Rs. 60,000/- per month in the first year and Rs. 70,000/- per month in the second year.
