MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCE REGULATION FOR SLOW/ ADVANCE LEARNERS

As per the decision of Executive Council meeting held on 17th December 2024 the University has approved the provision to implement multiple intelligence policy for Slow/ Advance learners as recommended by the Academic Council.

- In each class, students of multiple intelligence are present and also some of the students come from the Hindi medium and have difficulty in English language. Further recognising the fact that some of the students find it difficult to cope up with the academic rigor particularly in the initial years of their UG programme and keeping in view that UGC is also proposing early completion of the courses in its latest Regulations, the University has made a special provision for both slow learners as well as advance learners with the following conditions:
- 1.1 In addition to the existing twelve (12) courses of his/her current academic year an advance learner can opt additional two (02) courses from the immediate higher year (thus, 14 courses in total). Similarly, slow learners may take less than twelve (12) courses of their current academic year but not less than eight (08) courses of their current academic year for their promotion to next higher year.
- 1.2 Advance learners would be allowed to choose courses which are being offered in immediate higher year (corresponding odd/even semester as the case may be) only. However, an advance learner needs to clear at least twelve (12) courses out of the thirteen (13) or fourteen (14) courses as the case may be, in order to be eligible for promotion to the next higher year. For fourth year above numbers shall be read as ten (10) courses out of eleven (11) or twelve (12) courses he/she has opted.
- 1.3 Slow learners who have opted less than twelve (12) courses of their current academic year need to clear at least eight (08) courses in order to be eligible for promotion to the next higher year.

- 1.4 Slow learners who have opted less number of courses offered during the ongoing academic year must clear all the remaining course(s) in the immediate higher year (odd/even semester as the case may be) in order to be promoted to next higher year. Thus, no slow learner will be promoted to third (3rd) year without passing all the courses of first (1st) year. Similarly, this rule shall apply to all other promotions of slow learners to next higher classes.
- 1.5 The UG Programme has to be mandatorily completed in a minimum period of Five-Years and within the maximum period of Seven-Years in order to be eligible for the award of degree as per the Academic Regulations of the University.
- 1.6 Advance/ Slow learner students (as the case may be) are required to exercise this option well in advance and communicate their of selection of course(s) to the examination section (application form is available in the examination section) <u>latest</u> by 18th January 2025 for the ongoing semester.
- 1.7 For upcoming semesters, the above option needs to be exercised at least two weeks prior to the commencement of the semester.
