- g. Cyber Attacks Large-scale cyberattacks or system failures beyond the control of the parties.
- h. Procedure for Invocation:
 - The affected party shall notify the other party in writing within a specified period, providing details and evidence of the Force Majeure event.
 - Both parties shall make reasonable efforts to resume performance as soon as possible after the event ceases.
 - If the Force Majeure event continues for an extended period, either party may have the right to terminate the contract without any penalties.
- i. In such cases, neither party shall be held liable for any damages or penalties arising due to non-performance caused by Force Majeure.

Post-Implementation Support & Warranty:

 - Three (3) years warranty will be started from the date of acceptance certificate.
 - No "End of Life" (EOL) Components: If any active component is declared EOL during the warranty period, the vendor must replace it with a similar or higher specification at their own cost.
