Submission Guidelines

- The word limit of the manuscript shall be 4000-10,000 words excluding footnotes.
- An Abstract of 300 words, along with 5 (five) Keywords.
- The main body text in the manuscript must be in Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing and justified alignment.
- For footnotes, Times New Roman Style with a font size of 10 and 1.0 line spacing.
- Footnotes according to ILI Citation Format. No Bibliography/References.
- Manuscripts are to be submitted in <u>WORD</u> document. No other format would be accepted.
- A maximum of TWO authors are allowed.
- Plagiarism shouldn't be more than 10% and AI similarity should be 0%. The Manuscript should also be free from grammatical, spelling and other errors.

Conditions For Publication

Declaration by the Author(s)

- 1. The author(s) must declare that the research paper is original work, and he/she has no conflict of interest with the Publisher/CIRF-in-IPHD/CNLU.
- 2. That the research paper is unpublished and has not been sent to/accepted for publication by any other publication(s).
- 3. Once the research paper is accepted, for publication, it shall not be withdrawn, even if there is a delay in publication.
