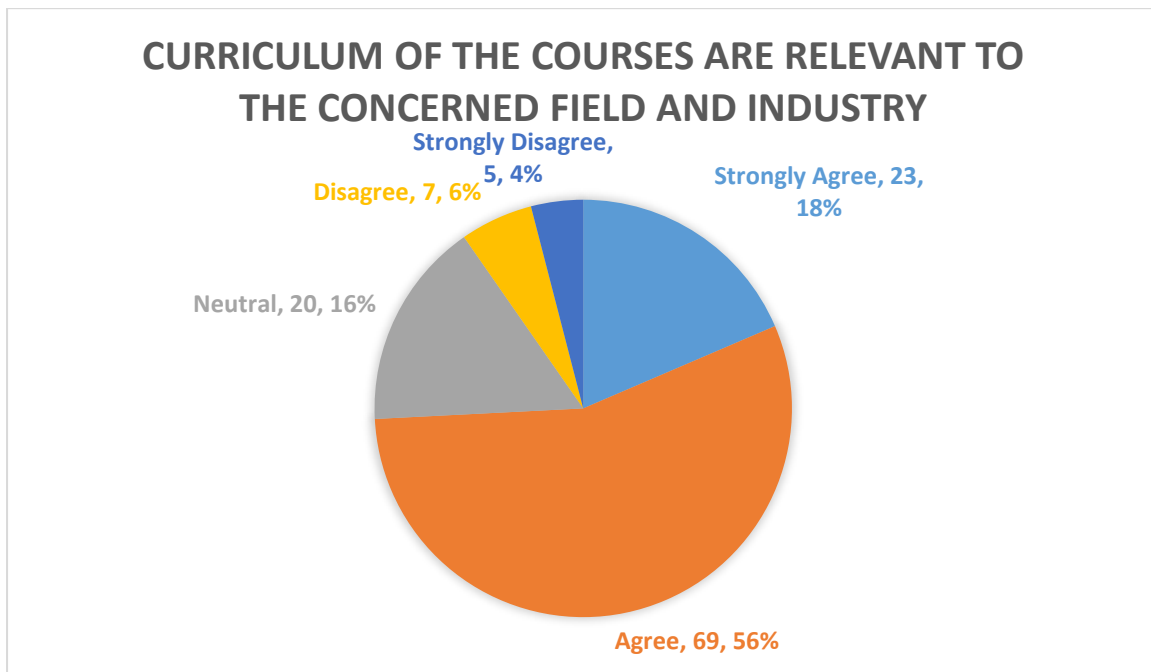

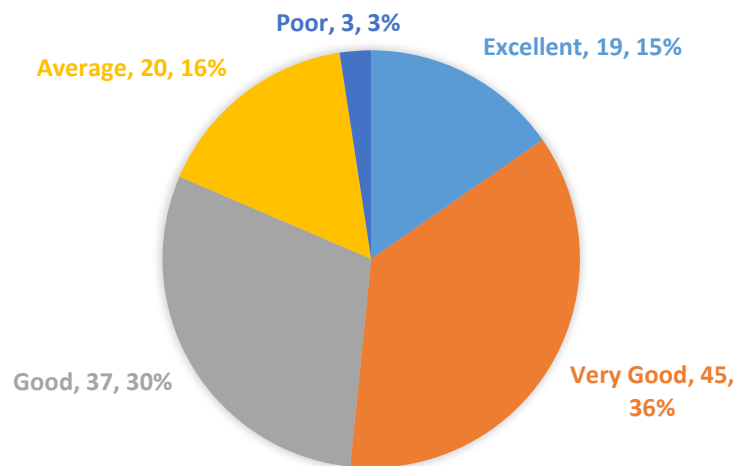
Student Satisfaction Survey Report

A Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted to assess the overall institutional performance of the Chanakya National Law University, Patna. Out of the twenty one questions asked in the survey, twenty questions were objective in nature and one was open-ended. The open-ended question aimed at eliciting suggestions by providing the students an opportunity to give suggestions and observations in their own words. Twenty objective questions of the survey covered various aspects such as, Relevance of the Curriculum, Knowledge and Understanding of the Teachers, Extracurricular activities, Integration of Crosscutting issues into the Curriculum, Imparting of Employability Skills, Fairness of the Internal Evaluation Process, Internship and Field visit Opportunities, Mentoring Process of the University, Use of ICT tools and online resources for teaching and learning process, and Students' participation in various co-curricular/extracurricular activities and committees etc. for continuous quality improvement.

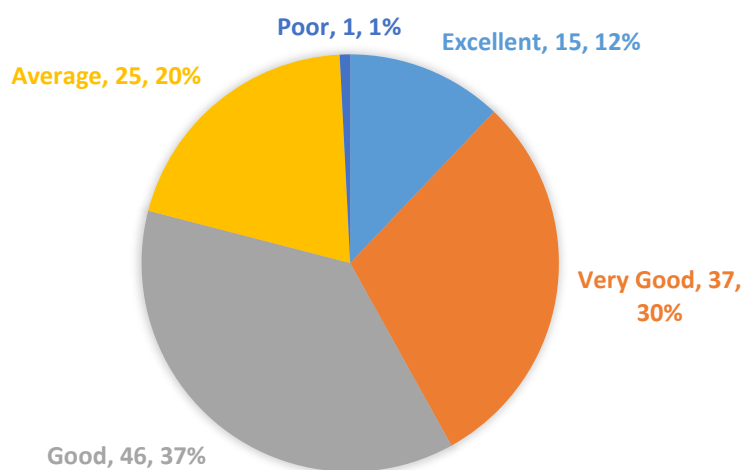
A total of 124 students participated in the survey. Their response was saved and analysed. Detailed Report of the student satisfaction survey is given below:



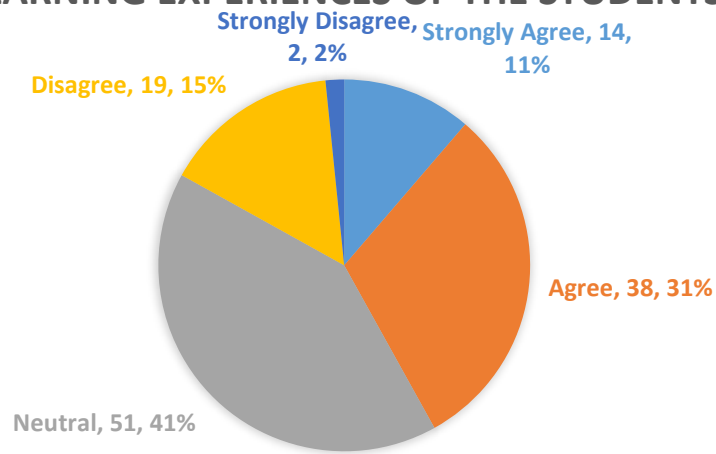
KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE TEACHERS OF THEIR RESPECTIVE COURSES



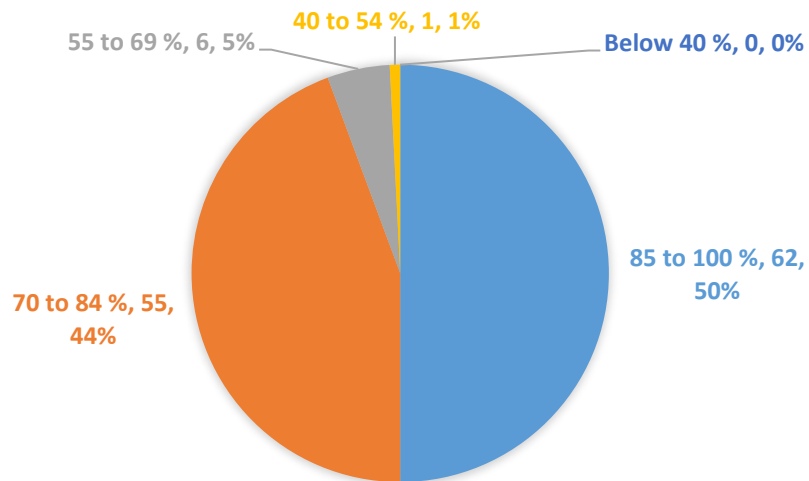
COMMUNICATION SKILL OF THE TEACHERS IN THE CLASS



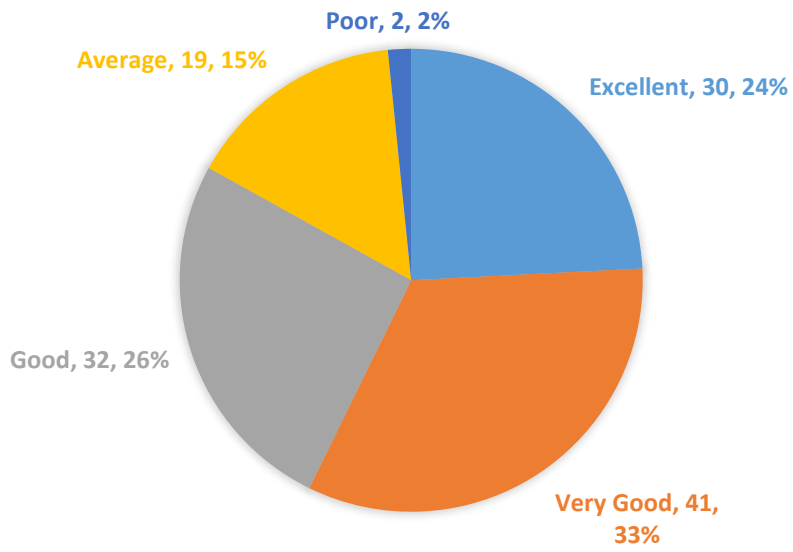
**INTERACTION IN CLASS AND TEACHING METHODS

LEARNING EXPERIENCES OF THE STUDENTS**



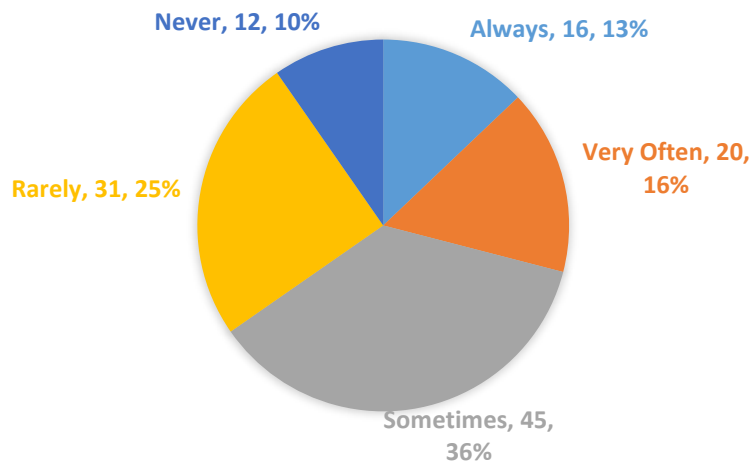
**PORTRION OF SYLLABUS THAT IS GENERALLY
COVERED BY THE TEACHERS**



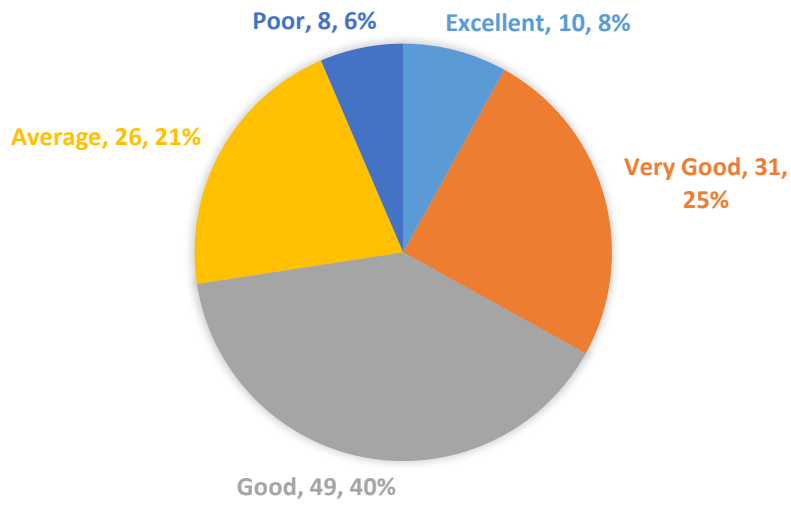
DOUBT CLARIFICATION BY THE TEACHERS



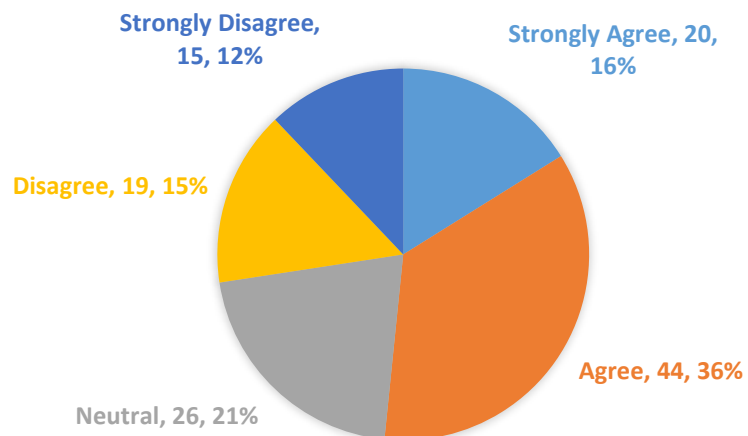

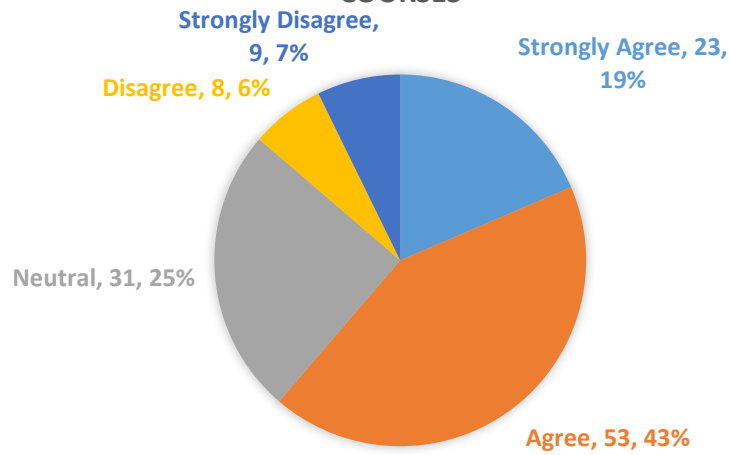
OVERALL QUALITY OF TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS IN THE UNIVERISTY



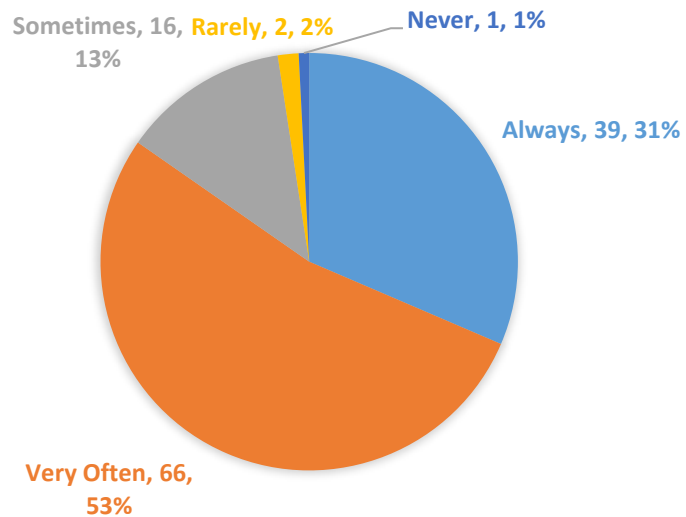

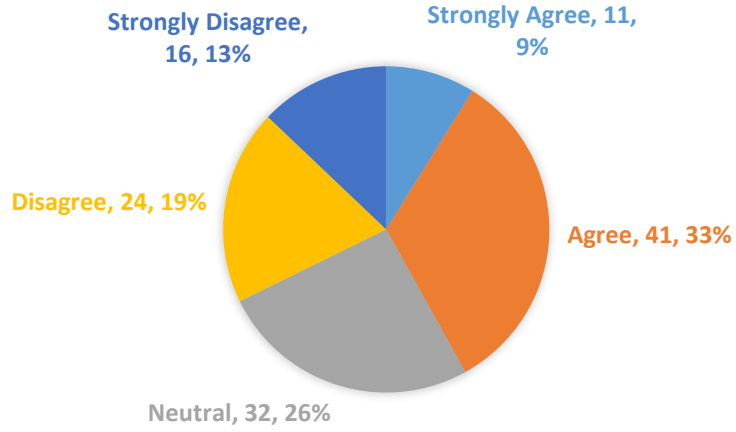

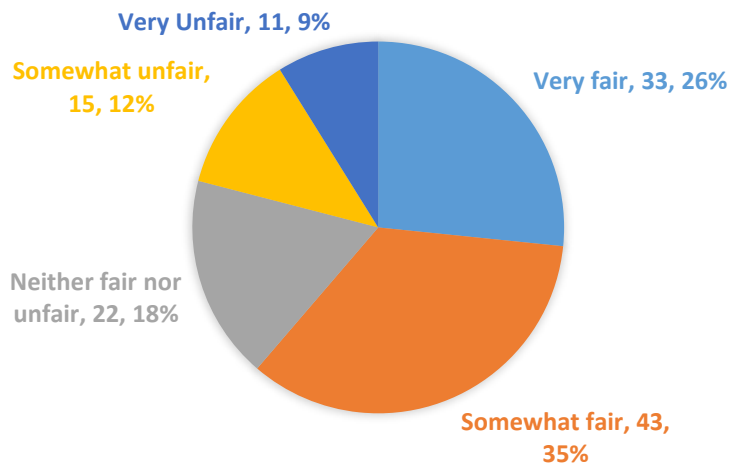

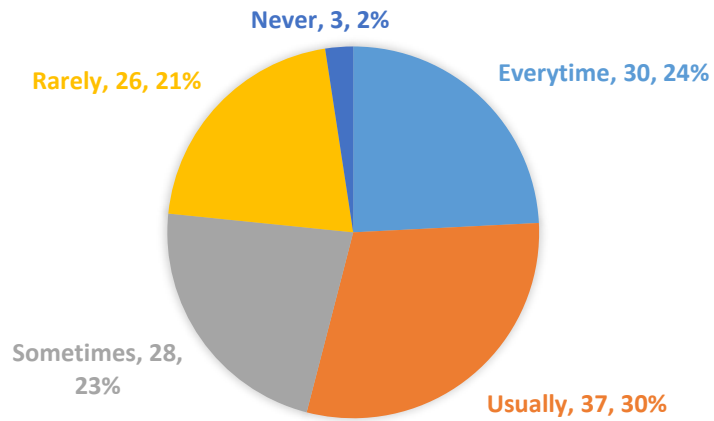

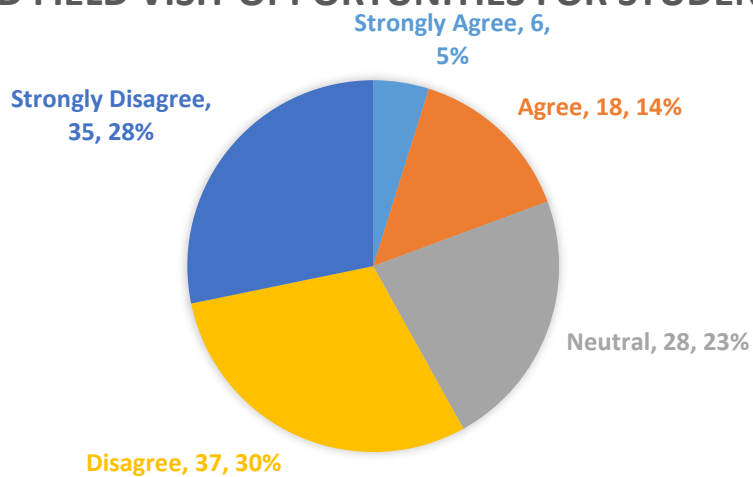
**INTERNAL EVALUATION PROCESS OF THE
UNIVERSITY IS**



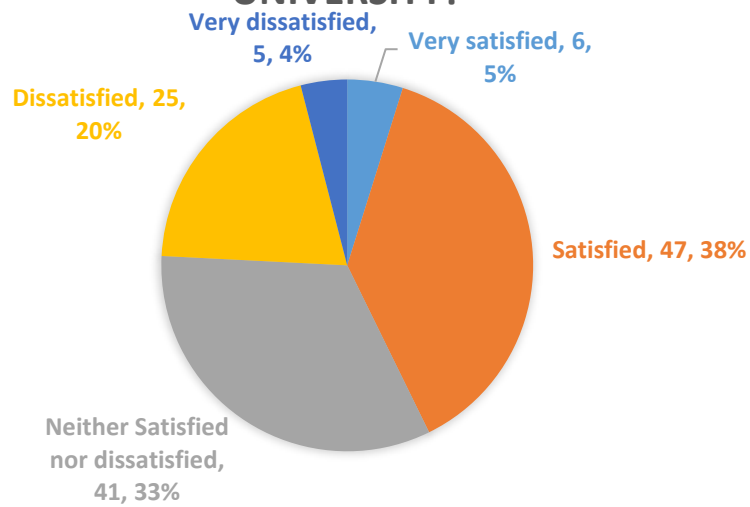

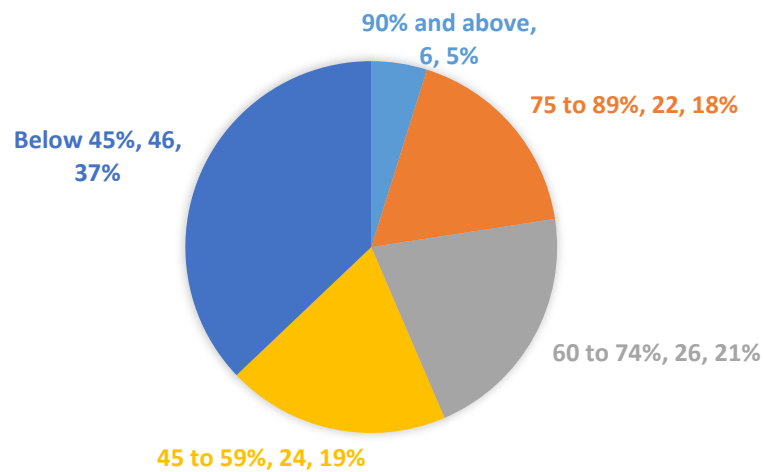

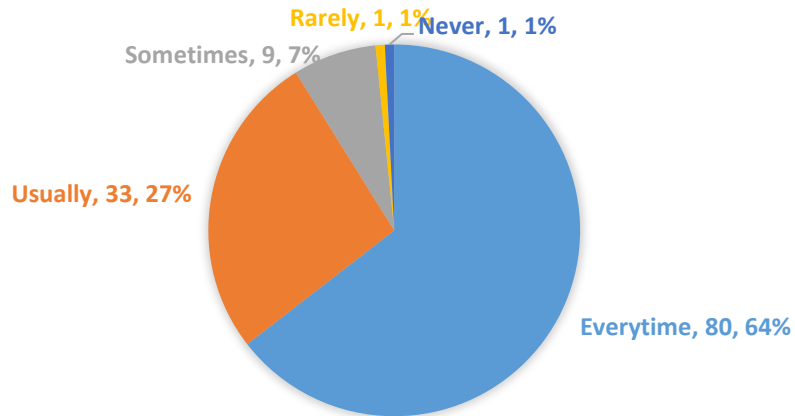
OVERALL, HOW SATISFIED ARE YOU WITH THE TEACHING AND MENTORING PROCESS OF THE UNIVERSITY?



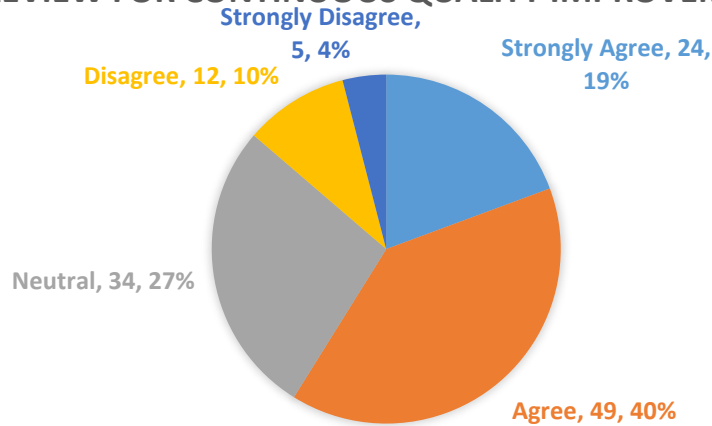

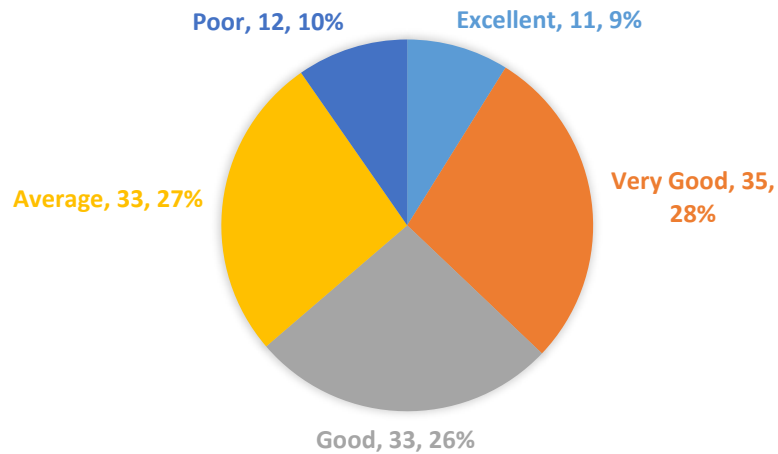
