CONCEPT NOTE

The National Workshop on Law and Literature seeks to open an interdisciplinary discussion between the two distinct fields, i.e. Law and Literature. The workshop primarily aims at exploring law in literature, law as literature and literature in law, through the lenses of interpretive, rhetorical and narrative practices that are shared by both domains. The workshop will endeavour to understand the interwoven nature between law and literature.

Since literature is a mirror of society, this workshop will discuss how common people understand law in their day-to-day life. It will focus on the social problems they want to resolve, their perceptions of law, the legal system and the society as a whole. The discussion will also reflect on whether the conflicts in the society can be resolved by law alone, and what is the role played by the common people in shaping the law.

The workshop will open discussions on the social, economic and political issues represented by classical authors in their works, and understand their portrayals through a socio-legal lens. It will also discuss how the study of literature is essential for the legal profession.
